**Instructions to voters**

If you make a mistake on your ballot or have a question, See an election inspector. (Absentee voters: Contact your municipal clerk.)

**1.) Select your party preference.**

You may vote in only ONE party section at a partisan primary.

- If you **designate a party preference** votes cast in that party section will be counted. Votes cast in any other party section will not be counted.

- If you **do not designate a party preference**, and you vote in more than one party, no votes will be counted.

**2.) Vote for individual candidates**

Vote for one candidate for each contest in your selected party.

- To vote for a name on the ballot, complete the arrow next to the name like this →

- To vote for a name that is not on the ballot, write the name on the line marked "write-in," and complete the arrow next to the name like this →
