Notice to voters: If you are voting on Election Day, your ballot must be initialed by two election inspectors. If you are voting absentee, your ballot must be initialed by the municipal clerk or deputy clerk. Your ballot may not be counted without initials. (See end of ballot for initials.)

General Instructions: If you make a mistake on your ballot or have a question, ask an election inspector for help (Absentee voters Contact your municipal clerk)

To vote for a name on the ballot, complete the arrow next to the name like this To vote for a name that is not on the ballot, write the name on the line marked "write-in" and complete the arrow next to the name like this

Special Instructions for Presidential Preference Vote

In the Presidential Preference Vote

- You may vote only ONCE
- If you vote more than once, your choices will not be counted

You have ONE of 3 choices.

- Vote for a candidate whose name is printed on this ballot
- Vote for an uninstructed delegation from Wisconsin to the national convention of the party you have chosen
- Write in the name of another person to become the presidential candidate of the party of your choice
